Stratham – Daniel S. Scerbo, 50, of Stratham, died Thursday, August 28, 2014, at his home after a valiant battle with colon cancer.

Dan was born in Brooklyn, New York, July 3, 1964, and graduated from Half Hollow Hills East High School in Dix Hills, NY with the Class of 1982. He also graduated from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, VA in 1986 with a dual degree in Computer Science and Mathematics. He was employed in the computer field as an Applications Solution Architect with Bottomline Technologies, a global provider of secure financial software.

Dan made his home in Stratham since 2000, coming from Hampton. Dan was active with the Stratham Recreational Department umpiring baseball, coaching basketball, and being involved with his boys' sporting activities. He also enjoyed running, bicycling, and Tae Kwon Do. More than anything Dan loved spending time with his wife Cathy and their three boys. His proudest accomplishment was the family they built together.

To Dan's many friends and neighbors, he was known for his wonderful sense of humor, heart-warming smile, amazing chocolate chip cookies, neighborhood award-winning lasagna, love of country music, his devotion to the New York Yankees, and his wildly-patterned shirts.

Dan shared 23 years of marriage with his wife, Cathleen A. (Riley) Scerbo.

In addition to his wife, he leaves three sons, Sean, Drew, and Ryan Scerbo of Stratham; his parents, Andrew R. and Regina Scerbo of Kings Park, Long Island, NY; his wife's parents, Chester and Diane Riley of Hampton; sister-in-law Patricia Riley Baker and husband Shane; his nephew Ethan Baker; and several aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
