Hampton – E. Joan Tapper, 85, of Hampton, died peacefully Friday, February 26, 2016 at home, surrounded by her closest friends.

She was born January 14, 1931 in Moncton, NB, Canada, the daughter of the late A. Herbert and Annie A. (Thompson) Robinson.
