

### Francis K. Beckwith III

Hampton, NH – Francis K. "Buddy" Beckwith, III, 64, of Hampton, formerly of Sutton, Mass., died, December 2, 2015 after a sudden illness.

He was born in Worcester, Mass., July 11, 1951 the son of the late Francis K. and Beatrice (Alexander) Beckwith, II. He was raised in Shrewsbury, Mass.


