Hampton – Irene E. LaRoche, 68, of Hampton and a former longtime resident of Manchester, died on Thursday, February 5, 2015 at home with loving and devoted family by her side.

She was born May 28, 1946 in Manchester, the daughter of the late Lionel and Yvonne (Lanoie) Nolet.

Irene was raised in Manchester and graduated from St. Anthony's High School with Class of 1964. She met the love of her life and future husband, Richard H. LaRoche, at a CYO dance, he was a freshman and she a sophomore. After their marriage in 1967, the young couple settled in Manchester to raise their family. Irene was a stay at home Mom and taking care of her family was always her top priority. When her children were older, she worked as a floral designer for Crystal Orchid Florist of Manchester, a position she enjoyed and held for many years. Irene loved the beach, the sun, the waves crashing ashore and the feel of burying her feet in the sand. She also loved cruising around with Richard in her VW Bug with the top down. The LaRoche family vacationed at Hampton Beach for years and she and Richard moved there permanently in 2006. For the last several years, Irene and Richard have shared their time between Hampton Beach and Passagrille, FL.

Family was her life. She adored her children and rarely missed any of their school or sporting events. Her grandchildren gave her special joy, whether coloring, dancing or playing games, she was immersed in their lives and was very proud of all their accomplishments. Irene will be sadly missed by her family and many friends.

In addition to her husband Richard of Hampton, family members include her son, Steven LaRoche and wife Amy of Fairfield, CT; her daughters, Lisa McPhail and husband Chris of Londonderry, Lesley Dunakin and husband Ted of Ripton, VT and Amy Cammarota of Merrimack; her grandchildren, Maeve and Kyle McPhail, Emma, Grace and Charlotte LaRoche, Addison and Hayden Dunakin and Erin Cammarota.
