Greenland – James L. Coombs, 51, of Greenland, died suddenly while skiing with friends at Sunday River in Bethel Maine, Friday, March 9, 2018. He was born August 28, 1966 in Newburyport, MA, the youngest of ten children, to Mary J. (Lonergan) Coombs of Greenland and the late Richard W. Coombs.

James was raised in Greenland and attended Greenland schools. He graduated from Portsmouth High School in 1984. An avid outdoorsman and athlete, James spent most of his time outside fishing, hunting, golfing, skiing, riding his motorcycle and exploring northern Maine, and especially liked the Katahdin Region. For the past 23 years, he was the owner and operator of Greenside Up, a Greenland-based landscape company.


