Rye – Mary Louise Begley “Mary Lou”, 86, of Rye, formerly of Lawrence, Mass., died Sunday, June 6, 2021 at her home surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Lawrence, on January, 10, 1935, a daughter of the late Francis and Gertrude Cookson.

Raised in Andover Mass., Mary Lou attended Pickford Academy before starting a varied career which included working as a bank teller, manufacturing associate at Raytheon and eventually as a teacher’s aide working with special needs children.

In 1952, she met Arthur Begley, the love of her life and they wed in 1954. They were together for loving and adventure filled 61 years before his passing in 2015.

Mary Lou loved her family and her friends. Her life was fulfilled by her faith in the Catholic Church and through helping others; most recently by knitting hats and scarves for homeless shelters and christening blankets for her church.
