Hampton – Mary F. O'Donnell, 74, a long-time resident of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 9, 2018, surrounded by her devoted family. She was born in New Haven, CT, on April 17, 1944, a daughter of the late Edward and Katherine (Wielgorecki) McNamara.

Mary was raised in New Haven, graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1962, and went on to earn her bachelor's degree with honors in nursing from Boston College in 1966.
