June 7, 1943 - July 6, 2016

Hampton – Therese L. Manfield, 73, of Hampton, passed away peacefully with loving family by her side on Wednesday, July 6, 2016 after a courageous battle with brain cancer.

She was born June 7, 1943 in Worcester, MA, daughter of the late Donathan and Irene (Dion) Gignilliat.

Therese was raised in Leicester and Worcester and graduated from Holy Name High School in Worcester and Mercy Hospital School of Nursing in Springfield, MA. A registered nurse, she was employed at Hahnemann Hospital in Worcester as well as Upjohn Healthcare in Springfield.

She married the love of her life, James J. Manfield in 1964. The couple lived in Worcester and Rutland, MA and settled in Southampton, MA in 1978. They moved to Hampton in 1988, to Exeter in 2000 and returned to Hampton two years ago. Therese was a volunteer for ten years at Exeter Hospital Oncology Department.

In addition to her husband she leaves her daughter, Christine Reading and her husband Michael of West Newbury, MA; her son, James K. Manfield and his wife Jill of Merrimack; four grandchildren, Julia, Megan, and Michelle Reading and Javin Manfield; her brother; Robert Gignilliat and his wife Margaret of Laurel, MD; her sister, Donna Gignilliat of Haverhill, MA; close family friends Lee, Heidi, Leigh, Erin, Todd, Riley and Tobin Field of Sidney, ME and a large extended family.
