Ocracoke, NC - Walter Potter Garrish, 90, a former resident of Hampton and Dover, passed away unexpectedly back in his hometown, Ocracoke, NC, on July 6, 2019. He was born in Beaufort, NC on February 1, 1929, a son of the late James Daniel and Ruby Austin Garrish. He attended school on Ocracoke and later graduated from High Point College, NC. He enlisted in the Air Force in October of 1949 and retired in 1971 as a Senior Master Sergeant with over 22 years of service to his country. After leaving the service, Walter worked for Raytheon Company where he retired in 1991.
