Hampton Falls – Walter Nichipor, 92, formerly of Hampton Falls, died Tuesday, January 26, 2016 at Oceanside Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation in Hampton.

He was born April 4, 1923 in Newburyport, Mass., the son of the late Zachary and Stephanie (Radinkewicz) Nichipor.

He was a graduate of Newburyport High School and was a veteran of WW II serving with the US Navy.

Mr. Nichipor was employed with the Internal Revenue Service in the Boston, Mass., Albany, NY and Portsmouth offices retiring in 1979 after 30 years of service.

He was a member of the First Congregational Church of Hampton, an over 60 year member of the Star in the East Lodge # 59 F & AM of Exeter, Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Portsmouth and Dover and the Bektash Temple Shrine.

He was the husband of the late Ruth L. (Lambert) Nichipor who predeceased him in 2010 and was also predeceased by three sisters and two brothers.
