



## Albert S. Sullivan

February 10, 1927 - January 14, 2014

Portsmouth – Albert S. Sullivan, 86, of Portsmouth, formerly of Exeter, died Tuesday, January 14, 2014 at the Edgewood Center in Portsmouth.

He was born February 10, 1927 in Lawrence, MA, a son of the late Joseph and Yolanda (Duhamel) Sullivan.

Albert was raised in Lawrence, MA and was a graduate of Lawrence High. He worked as an electrical engineer for Mass Electric and retired in 1996 after more than 40 years of service. He married Criscilla “Terry” Sullivan in 1970 and the couple relocated from Haverhill, MA to Exeter. He and Terry loved to travel and had visited extensively in the United States and abroad.

He was a WWII veteran of the U.S. Navy.
