Portsmouth – Alexander John Price, 25, of Portsmouth and formerly of Exeter, passed away on Thursday, May 4, 2023, from injuries he sustained in an automobile accident in North Hampton. Alex was born in Exeter on November 26, 1997, a son of Heidi (Rockwood) Price of Portsmouth and John R. Price of Hampton.

Alex was raised in Exeter and graduated from Exeter High School with the Class of 2016. Alex loved basketball and started playing in the local youth leagues when he was just 8 years old. He excelled in the sport and was a star player for the Blue Hawks at Exeter High. His love for the game continued after high school as he became a coach and mentor with the local youth leagues including Journeyman Basketball and the St. Thomas and Sacred Heart School teams.

In addition to basketball, Alex enjoyed listening to and making his own rap music. He even hosted his own podcast covering many topics, but mostly focused on music and sports.

He was a thoughtful, caring, and compassionate young man. Alex loved and enjoyed many things but his family, including his son, Carter and his fiancée, Jordan Jones, were always the most important parts of his life. Alex talked with his brother Josh many times about his desire to have Carter enjoy

experiences, events, and places above material things. He was focused on the future with his beautiful family.

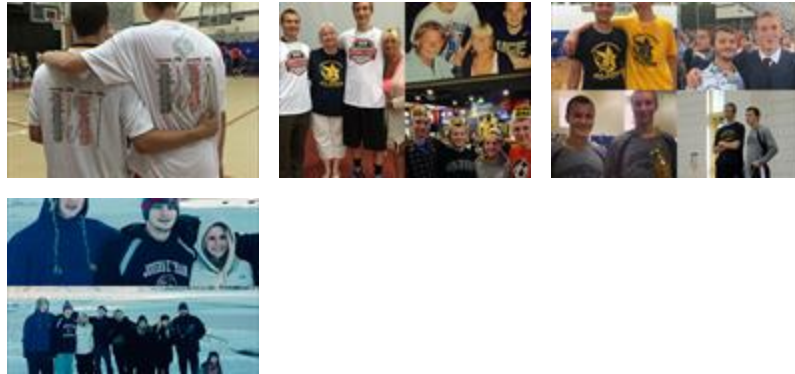
