Hampton – Alexandra N. “Ally” Palmieri, 26, of Hampton, died Saturday, November 14, 2015 at UMass Memorial Medical Center, Worcester, Mass.

She was born April 7, 1989 in Honolulu, HI the daughter of Robert D. and Elaine S. (Saunders) Palmieri of Hampton.

Ally was raised in Hampton and graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 2007 and Dean College in Franklin, Mass., in 2009. While growing up in Hampton, she participated in sports with the Hampton Youth Association and enjoyed basketball, cheerleading, and snowboarding. Her favorite place was enjoying the tranquility at the beach.

She was employed as a registered medical assistant in the healthcare field.

Ally was also a registered organ donor. Prior to her donation, a moment of silence and words of remembrance offered were: “Ally was a bright, vibrant, young woman who cared more for others than herself. She has two beautiful boys’ ages 3yrs and 10 months who she loved with all her heart. She was always the first to help others less fortunate than her. Her smile would light up a room and her contagious laughter would keep everyone smiling. She will be

missed by everyone who loved her, cherished her, and knew her for the person she was.”

In addition to her parents, she leaves her two sons, Logan and Miles, her brother, Bobby Palmieri, Jr., all of Hampton, her paternal grandparents, William and Helen Palmieri of Marshfield, Mass., her maternal grandmother, Virginia Saunders of Pine Plains, NY, several aunts, uncles and cousins.

She was pre-deceased by her maternal grandfather Francis J Saunders of Catskill, NY.

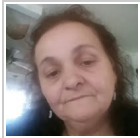

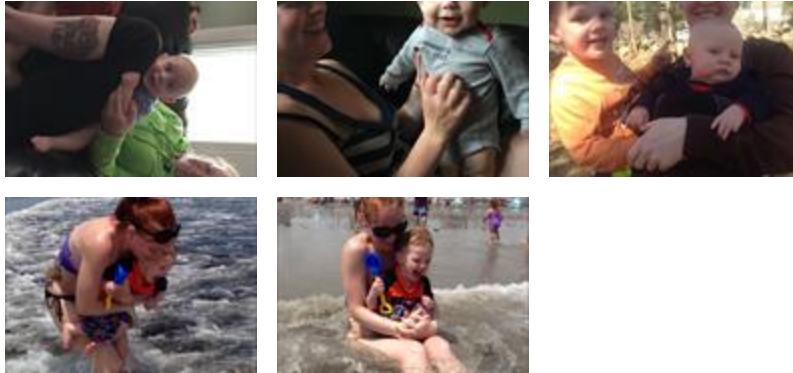
