Exeter, NH – Allaire (Blake) Nownes, 86, of Exeter, formerly of Hampton, died Tuesday, October 1, 2013 at Exeter Hospital.

Allaire, daughter of the late Dr. Roger N. and Virginia (Carr) Blake, was born in Oradell, NJ September 27, 1927.

Mrs. Nownes was employed by Area Homemakers – Family Services Agency in Portsmouth as a homemaker and as a scheduler in the office, retiring in 1990 after 15 years of service.

Mrs. Nownes' service to her church and community included being a 42 year member of the First Baptist Church of Hampton and a current member of the First Baptist Church of Exeter. She served both churches as a deaconess and Sunday school teacher and was active in the women's and music ministries, and as a missions coordinator.

She was a member of the Christian's Women's Club of the Seacoast and was involved with many bible studies in the area. She served on the board of directors for the Area Homemakers of Portsmouth, was a volunteer driver for the former FISH organization and later the Ecumenical Transportation Committee.

She shared 61 loving years of marriage with her late husband, Frank R. Nownes.
