



## Allan W. MacGregor

July 17, 1952 - July 21, 2014

Portsmouth – Allan W. MacGregor, 62, of Portsmouth, died suddenly on Monday, July 21, 2014 at his home.

He was born July 17, 1952 in Haverhill, MA, a son of Pauline (Wiley) MacGregor of York, ME and the late Malcolm G. MacGregor, Sr.

Allan was raised in Sandown and graduated from Timberlane Regional High School. He has lived in Portsmouth for the last 35 years. An avid surfer, he and his cousin Mark opened Macs' Surf Shop in 1969, the first ever surf shop in Rye. He went on to earn his Associates Degree from The Thompson School of Culinary Arts at UNH and had cooked at The Red Jacket Inn, North Conway, NH. Allan was well known throughout the seacoast and will be missed by his family and many friends.

In addition to his mother, Allan is survived by his brother, Malcolm G. MacGregor, Jr. and his wife Theresa, of Durham; his sisters, Martha Lardent and her husband Craig of North Hampton, Hannah MacGregor of York, ME and Amanda MacGregor Peirce of Brookfield. He also leaves his nieces, Jennifer Hall of Dover and Elizabeth Hall of York, ME.

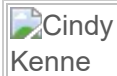
