North Hampton – Allen L. Shackley, 76, of North Hampton died peacefully on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 at the Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

He was born in Biddeford, ME on November 17, 1940 a son of the late Morris Shackley and Eunice (Grove) Kimball.

Raised throughout Maine, he graduated from Casco Bay High School in Portland, ME. Leaving school early, he enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served 2 years in Milton, FL and 2 years in West Malling, England.

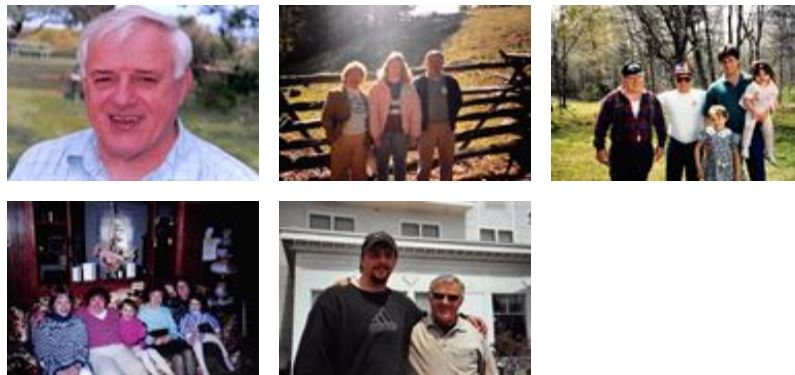

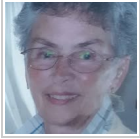
