



Amelia J. Gendron

Grafton, MA - Amelia J. "Millie" Gendron, 91, of South Grafton, died Thursday, April 22, 2010 at Beaumont Rehabilitation and Skilled Nursing Center in Northbridge surrounded by her family.

She is survived by her daughter, Joyce A. Gibree and her husband Paul of Northbridge, her son, John A.
