Seabrook – Amy Stasia Perkins, 43, of Seabrook, died Monday, February 24, 2014 at her home surrounded by her family after a lengthy battle with brain cancer (GBM).

She was born in Bennington, VT, November 15, 1970 and the family moved to the seacoast in 1978. Amy attended local schools and graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1988.

Amy was employed as a polysomnographer for Portsmouth Regional Hospital for nearly ten years and prior to this worked for Anna Jaques Hospital in Newburyport, Mass. in the cardiology department.

She was a member of the Rand Memorial Church serving as a Sunday school teacher, the Raymond E. Walton American Legion Post 70 Women's Auxiliary, was a self-taught pianist, and was presently serving her third term as a representative to District 20 of the State of NH General Court.

Family members include her husband, Lawrence B. "KoKo" Perkins, her son, Daumanic Fucile, her daughter, Katelyn Perkins, her father, Dennis C. Keegan all of Seabrook, her mother, Maureen J. 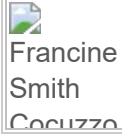
