North Hampton - Amy Louise Peters (née Hochschwender) a long-time North Hampton resident, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 29, 2024 at the age of 63, surrounded by loving family.

She was born on January 9, 1961 in Pelham, NY a daughter of the late Claire (Hamel) and Jerry Hochschwender.

She was a special, artistic soul and loved her family fiercely. Amy fostered a profound passion for cycling, and has been a life-long advocate for the benefits of physical exercise. She participated in the Pan Mass Challenge for 15 years, raising hundreds of thousands of dollars for cancer research. She volunteered regularly at public food banks and was beloved by her community. She was deeply cherished by her entire family, friends, and any person that was fortunate enough to experience her kindness, warmth, humor and compassion.

Amy is survived by her husband, Jeff Peters; her children, Courtney and Cody Peters, and her grandson, Wyatt Ramos.

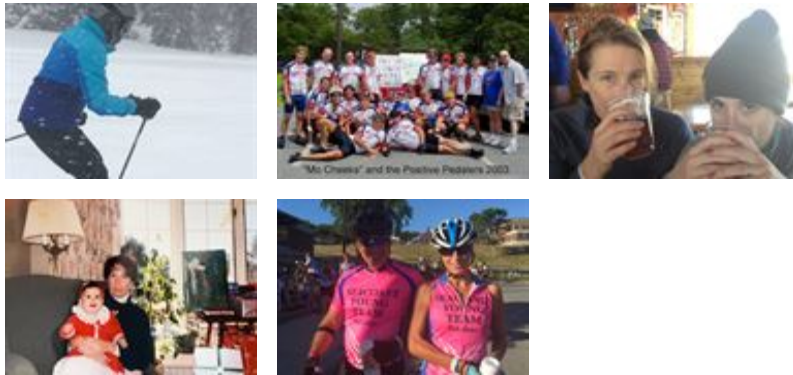
