Portsmouth – Angelina A. Panarese, 78, of Portsmouth, died suddenly Wednesday, May 13, 2015 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

Angie was born August 1, 1936 in Boston, MA a daughter of the late Ralph and Tillie (Elkins) Panarese. She was a lifelong resident of Portsmouth.

Angie first worked as a waitress at various restaurants throughout the seacoast, so she could stay home and take care of her children. She later co-founded Angelina's Pasta Shoppe in 1980 before selling the restaurant and working with her daughter at the former Celebrity Sandwich in Portsmouth.

After retirement she enjoyed volunteering for various hospice organizations, participating in the weekly rosary services, preparing mercy meals and being a Eucharist minister for Corpus Christi Parish in Portsmouth.

Angie most of all loved spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. She was a mother and grandmother "Non" to all. She enjoyed traveling to Italy and Florida, swimming in her pool, knitting prayer shawls and giving cooking lessons to many people, young and old. She never met a person that she didn't want to feed.

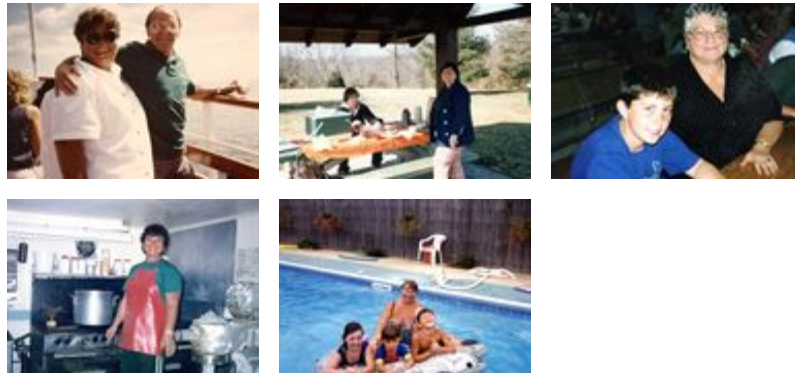
