



## Ann Phyllis Bond

November 19, 1935 - February 8, 2026

Saugus, MA – Ann P. “Bondi” Bond, 90, of Saugus, passed away on Sunday, February 8, 2026, with her family by her side. She was born in Boston, Massachusetts, on November 19, 1935, a daughter of the late Paul and Alice (DeCicco) Mercurio.

Ann was raised in Revere and attended Revere High School. Following her schooling, she married her husband, Gordon, in 1956. They made their home in Revere until 1964, when they moved to Saugus, where she remained for the rest of her life.

Ann worked as a waitress for many years and, in the late 1980s, began a second career as a nurse’s aide at the Veterans Home in Chelsea. She took great pride in her work caring for soldiers and retired in the early 2000s.

She had a special gift in the kitchen and could make anything taste delicious, rarely measuring, always cooking from instinct and love.

She enjoyed spending summers at camp on Lovell Lake in Sanbornville with her longtime partner, Big Al, rarely missing a weekend. Ann will be remembered as an independent woman with a deep love of her country. She was an avid animal lover and owned many German Shepherds over the years. Her most beloved companion was her Shih Tzu, Katie, whom she loved

walking around Saugus.
