



Ann C. (Gatto) Urquhart

May 27, 1937 - November 3, 2024

Exeter - Ann Caroline (Blethen) Gatto Urquhart, 87, of Exeter, NH, formerly of Plymouth, MA, passed away on November 3, 2024 after a long and fulfilling life. She was a devoted wife, mother, daughter, sister, and friend.

Ann was born on May 27, 1937, the second of three girls born to Otis Wood and Clara Pearl Blethen in Plainville, CT. After graduating from Plainville High School, she obtained her BS in Sociology from Tufts.

While a college intern at the Boston Juvenile Court, she met and fell in love with probation officer Nicholas Gatto, a widower with two young children. They were married on June 13, 1959. They had four additional children and raised their family in Roslindale, MA. There they lived happily until Nick's sudden passing in September 1986.

In the early 1970s, Ann obtained her real estate license and became a very successful realtor in the greater Boston area. She owned and operated her own company, Ann Gatto Real Estate, in West Roxbury, MA, in the late 1980s and early 1990s.

She later remarried Wesley Urquhart of Wayland, MA. The couple then moved to Plymouth, MA, where she lived until 2023.

Ann was predeceased by her parents, her husband Nicholas Gatto, her second husband Wesley Urquhart, her sister Patricia Krusell, and her grandson Joseph N. Gatto.

A loving mother, Ann is survived by her children: Joseph P. Gatto of Dedham, MA; Patricia DiCienzo of Hanover, MA.; Michael Gatto of Exeter, NH; Christopher Gatto of Chelmsford, MA; Laura Carvey of Odessa, FL; and Kimberly Gatto of Franklin, MA. She was a beloved grandmother to Joseph, Anthony, Danielle, Scott, Benjamin, Andrew, Elizabeth, and Nicholas Gatto; and Nicholas DiCienzo. She also leaves behind four great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews, as well as her sister, Betsysusan Currie.
