Seabrook Beach – Ann M. Wilk, 75, of Seabrook Beach, passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 1, 2025.

Born in Lowell, MA on July 17, 1950, she was the daughter of the late Henry Rousseau and Kay (McCarthy) Rousseau. Raised in Lowell, Ann graduated from Keith Hall with the Class of 1968. She earned her bachelor's degree from Merrimack College in 1972 and later received her master's from Lowell Technological Institute.

Ann dedicated her life to education, spending the majority of her career teaching at Lowell High School. After retiring in 2006, she pursued a second career in real estate, earning her license and working for several years at Carey & Giampa, specializing in rental properties. Ann was also an active member of the Seabrook Beach Civic Association and the Ladies Social Club of Seabrook.

A passionate runner and walker, Ann loved the beach and seafood, but her greatest joy was spending time with her grandchildren.

She is survived by her husband of 52 years, Edward Wilk of Seabrook Beach; her sons, Jonathan Wilk and his spouse Kerri of Merrimac, MA, and Kendrick Wilk and his spouse Bethany of San Diego, CA; her beloved grandchildren,

Madeleine, Michael, Alise, Zoe, and Ada; her sister Brenda O'Brien and her spouse Dan of Wells, ME; and several nieces and nephews.
