Seabrook – Annette L. Karonis, 83, formerly of Seabrook, died Sunday, January 4, 2015 at Brentwood Nursing & Rehabilitation Center in Danvers, Mass., with loving family at her side.

She was born April 27, 1931 in Salem, Mass., the daughter of the late Frederick and Liane (DuBois) Proulx. Raised in Beverly, Mass., Annette was a 1949 graduate of St. Mary's High School. She attended Burdett College in Boston, Mass. and worked as a secretary in the employment office of United Shoe Machinery Corporation "The Shoe" in Beverly for years.

She married the love of her life, Joseph on October 3, 1953 upon his return from the Korean War. The couple lived in Danvers and Middleton, and Lynnfield, Mass., before relocating to Seabrook in 1999, after falling in love with the seacoast while camping.
