Portsmouth – Arthur C. Todd, 81, of Portsmouth, formerly of North Hampton and Hampton, died Saturday, May 9, 2015 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

He was born in Greenland, October 31, 1933 the son of the late Arthur C. and Mary E. (Ireland) Todd.

Mr. Todd was a graduate of Portsmouth High School with the class of 1952. He worked as a sales representative for the former Scott Jewelers in Portsmouth for 39 years retiring in 1987.

A longtime resident of Greenland he moved to North Hampton 1995. He was a member and served on the altar committee at the Greenland Community Congregational Church. Mr. Todd was also a member of the Greenland Historical Society and the former Ocean Side Grange #260 of Hampton.

Family members include his sister, Dorothy Amazeen of Twin Falls, ID, one niece, Linda Amazeen of Shoreline, WA, one nephew Vincent Amazeen of Jerome, ID and several cousins.

He was predeceased by his brother, Richard Jewell Todd.
