



## Arthur C. Wilson III

May 14, 1930 - November 11, 2022

Exeter – Arthur C. “Buster” Wilson III, 92, of Exeter, formerly of Seabrook died on Veterans Day, Friday, November 11, 2022 at the Exeter Hospital. Arthur was born in Seabrook on May 14, 1930, a son of the late Arthur C. and Ellen (Felch) Wilson, Jr.

He was raised in Seabrook and attended Amesbury High School. Arthur was an Army veteran of the Korean War and the recipient of the Purple Heart for injuries he sustained in combat. After returning from the war, Buster married the love of his life, the late Barbara (Frascone) Wilson. They settled in Seabrook to raise their family and Arthur worked as a cook for Sailor Bill’s as well as a security guard for the former Yankee Greyhound Track in Seabrook.

Buster was a member of the Saint James Lodge 102 F. & A.M., a member of the Raymond E. Walton American Legion Post 70 of Seabrook, a member of the Disabled American Veterans, the Combat Infantryman Association and the 23rd Infantry Regiment Association.

He enjoyed fishing, hunting and the Boston Red Sox but his family, especially his grandchildren, were the most important part of his life. Arthur loved his family and he will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

Family members include his five daughters, Pamela Randall and her husband

Herbert of Effingham, NH, Lisa Roberts and her husband Derrick, Luannah Soars and her husband Peter, Deidra Wilson and Kimberly Wilson, all of Seabrook, 10 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren, 8 great great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to Barbara, his beloved wife of over 54 years, Buster was predeceased by his son, Arthur C. Wilson, IV and his brothers, Gary and Edward Wilson.
