Hampton, NH – Ashley L. Collins, 30, of Hampton, died suddenly at her home on Christmas Day, Thursday, December 25, 2014.

Ashley was born in Newburyport on August 19, 1984, a daughter of Carla J. (Eaton) Collins and Lawrence R. Collins, both of Seabrook, NH.

She was raised in Salisbury and graduated from Triton Regional High with the Class of 2002. Ashley had been attending Northern Essex Community College and was close to completion in their radiology technician program. She moved to Hampton and had worked on the wait staff at The Old Salt in Hampton.

In addition to her parents, family members include her sister, Amanda L. Rogers, her husband Anthony and their children, Ashley's nieces, Annika and Elsa all of Topsfield. She also leaves her puppy Charlie.

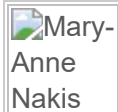
