Exeter - Tenaglia, Attilio James "Jim", of Exeter, formerly of Haverhill and Andover, MA, passed away on Tuesday, October 26th, 2021 at the age of 96 after having previously been diagnosed with ALS. He was the beloved husband of Sandra (Wiles) Tenaglia with whom he was married for 44 years. Jim was born on November 11, 1924 to the late Mary and Attilio Tenaglia of Lynn, MA. He was the twin brother of the late Lydia Tenaglia of Lynn.

Jim graduated from Lynn English High School and attended the University of Wisconsin (Special Navy Program) for a year. He was a Navy veteran of World War II, the South Pacific campaign. Jim worked for General Electric for 37 years in the Jet Engine Division. After retiring from General Electric he worked for AAA Merrimack Valley for 15 years as a tour director. Jim loved spending time with his children, grandchildren, and friends; traveling with his wife all over North American and Europe; and cheering on the Patriots.

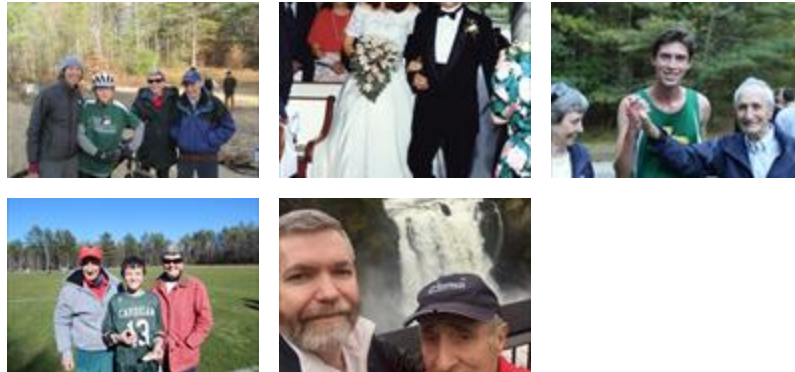
