Pittsfield – Avis A. (Pevear) Denis, 89, of Pittsfield and a former longtime resident of Seabrook, passed away peacefully on Thursday, November 9, 2023. She was born in Seabrook on November 5, 1934, a daughter of the late Harold and Evelyn (Fowler) Pevear.

Avis was a lifelong resident of Seabrook until relocating to Pittsfield to be closer to family as her health declined. While in Seabrook she was very active in her community as a member of the Rand Church, a volunteer at the voting booths, a very important part of the Seabrook Historical Society and was also a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution (D.A.R.). She loved doing genealogy and had thoroughly researched the Pevear & Fowler family trees.

Avis had a silly sense of humor and a quick wit. She was a hard-working single parent who raised her kids by herself while also caring for her own parents as they aged.

Avis leaves her sons, Andrew Denis (Deanna) and Matthew Denis Sr. of Pittsfield, and David Denis of Dover. She also leaves brothers, Harold Pevear, Jr. of Newmarket and Robert Pevear (Leora) of Unity, her grandchildren, David Bridges (Angela), Seth Bridges, Jesse Denis (Samantha), Matthew Denis Jr., Andrew Denis Jr., and Stephanie Quandt and her great-

granddaughters, Lyra and Daisy.

She was predeceased by her parents and her brother, Sidney Pevear, Sr. and her Sister-In-Law Connie Pevear.

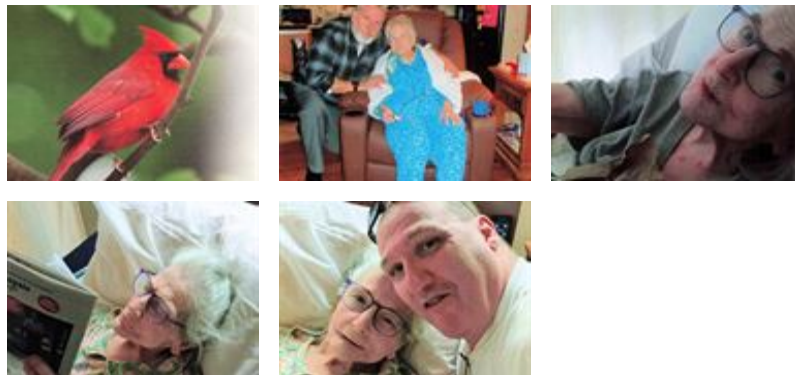
