nature. One of her most treasured memories was traveling to Greece with her husband Rick to celebrate her 60th birthday. She also enjoyed knitting, dining out, and always carried herself with impeccable style and grace.

In addition to her mother, daughters and husband, Aviva is also survived by her sister, Jennifer Troobnick and her sister-in-law, Robbin Troobnick.

Aviva was predeceased by her father Eugene Troobnick, and her brother Mark Troobnick.

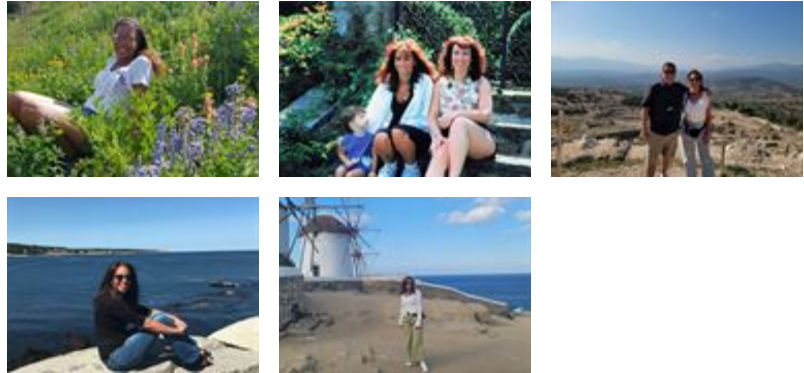
