



## Barbara Ann Bednarz

August 2, 1940 - March 29, 2019

North Hampton – Barbara Ann Bednarz, 78, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 29, 2019, following a period of declining health, while under hospice care at Pruitt Health in Raleigh, NC. because she could always head down to the freezer and pull out a meal and dessert. As the Christmas holidays got close, she would delight in baking dozens and dozens of Christmas cookies. These were shared with friends and family and became one of the highlights of the holiday season. Most of all, Barbara loved ending each day with a big bowl of ice cream and a book. An avid reader, she was well known at her hometown library. When a new mystery or book by a local author came out, she was near the top of the request list and relished reading the new release.

In addition to Stan, her husband of nearly 58 years, she is survived by her son John Bednarz, his wife Terri and her granddaughter, Natalie of Raleigh, NC. Barbara also leaves her sister Kathy Piotrowski and her husband Michael, her brothers Henry Fil and his wife Linda and Donald Fil and his wife Barbara, her sister-in-law, Beverly Adams and her husband Joseph and many dear friends. 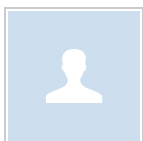
