Hampton - Barbara Ann Burke, nee Collard, 85, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Monday, February 23, 2026. She was the loving wife of William T. Burke (Retired, Chief of Police Portsmouth 1987 to 1999.)

Born August 22, 1940, in Arlington, TX, Barbara Ann was the daughter of the late Clarence Benjamin and Sarah Louise (Barber) Collard. Raised and educated in Dumas, Texas, Barbara Ann attended Dumas High School. From there she went on to attend North Texas University, graduating in 1962. She worked as a teacher in Amarillo and Pampa Texas. On a spontaneous trip to California with her best friend Tommy-Kay, she met William on a blind date in Hermosa Beach, CA on July 29, 1964. They were married 6 weeks later on September 4, 1964; it was love at first sight and a marriage of 61 years! In October of 1965 William Jr was born and in November of 1973 Katherine was born. In Ann's time in California she worked for the Los Angeles Unified School District and later as a Librarian in Malaga Cove. They made a home in Palos Verdes, CA for nearly 17 years and would drive every summer from Los Angeles to Cape Cod, visiting Texas family on the way, seeing the country then enjoying the sands of the Cape, which Ann truly loved. In 1987 they relocated to New Hampshire where Ann enjoyed friends at Newcomer's Club and substitute teaching at Newmarket Jr High School. She loved walking the beach in Cape Cod, looking for sea glass and she loved tending to her garden in New Hampshire.

As a mother , teacher and community member with stints on both coasts, her dedication to family and community is nothing short of outstanding. She taught us accountability and to never give up. She did this through the patience of Job, and the humor and kindness and compassion of a true Texan: Firm but fair, loving and consistent in making sure we kids were accountable in our actions and upbringing.

In addition to her husband, Barbara Ann is survived by her children, William T. Burke Jr. and his wife Donna of Morro Bay, CA, and Katherine Jean Smith and her husband Aaron of San Marcos, CA, her siblings, Nancy Hilliard of Flower Mound, TX, Roberta Jean Collard of Lewisville, TX, Benjamin Collard III of Eagle Nest, NM, and Daniel Farley and his wife Laura of Big Spring, TX. She also leaves her 6 grandchildren, Shaw, Daniel, Kayla, Dylan, Magdalena, and Celeste, as well as many loving nieces and nephews.
