Hampton Falls – Barbara J. Burns, 83, of Hampton Falls, passed away peacefully on Monday, October 6, 2025. She was born in Weymouth, MA on November 30, 1941 the daughter of the late Sydney and Jean (Johnson) Harris. Raised in Weymouth she graduated from Hingham High School with the Class of 1959. She went on to make her home on Sicard Street in Hampton for a few years before settling in Hampton Falls in 1983.

Barbara worked as a clerk for John Hancock for 19 years before leaving to devote her life to raising her family. Barbara was a volunteer at the Hampton Falls Library for many years, and also assisted with the local 4-H club. She was active with the Hampton Falls Historical Society and served as assistant moderator at the town elections for many years. An avid crafter and talented needlepoint artist, she also enjoyed crocheting and tracing her Scottish heritage. Barbara loved children and enjoyed caring for her only granddaughter from infancy into elementary school. Barbara loved to attend any events from dance recitals to theatre to sports games to support her granddaughter.

She is survived by her husband of 47 years, John J. Burns of Hampton Falls. She also leaves behind her children: John J. Burns Jr. of Somersworth, David H. Burns of Hampton Falls, and Betty Coccozza and her husband, Michael, of Northwood. She is also survived by her granddaughter, Kaelin Coccozza.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her sister Dorothy Harris.

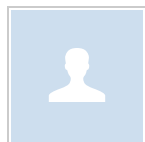

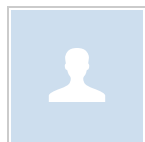
