Exeter – Barbara Ann Driscoll, 93, of Exeter, formerly of Hampton and Methuen, MA passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 3, 2025. Barbara was born on November 18, 1932 in Methuen, MA, the daughter of the late Arthur A. Bailey, II and Emily E. (Thomas) Bailey.

Barbara was raised in Methuen and graduated from E. F. Searles High School in 1950. She attended McIntosh College and the College for Life Long Learning and had been employed with the former New England Telephone until her retirement in 1988. After her retirement she worked part time at J.C. Penny's, Continental Cable and Timberland.
