North Hampton – Barbara J. Flynn, formerly of Rye, died Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at the Exeter Hospital.

Mrs. Flynn was born in Warwick, RI October 29, 1942, the daughter of the late Robert and Katherine (Riley) Easdon. She was a 1960 graduate of Nashua High School. A North Hampton resident for the past three years, she resided in Rye for 38 years coming from Methuen, MA.

Barbara was appointed Treasurer for the Town of Rye in 1982 and held that position for 23 years, retiring in 2005.

Mrs. Flynn was a communicant of Saint Theresa Church in Rye Beach, enjoyed gardening and loved spending time with her grandchildren.
