



## Barbara Ann Granger

December 5, 1933 - February 15, 2025

North Hampton - Barbara Ann (Maroney) Granger passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her loving family on February 15th, 2025, at age 91 years young. Born December 5th, 1933 in Haverhill MA, to (late) parents Joseph P. Maroney and Eleanor (Murphy) Maroney. She is predeceased by her devoted husband of almost 62 years, Edward E. Granger Jr, son Steven W Granger.

Barbie was raised in Haverhill MA, in a multigenerational home with loving grandparents, parents, uncle, and cousins that are more accurately described as sisters, Kathleen (Murphy) Compagnone and Jean (Murphy) Gautreau. She was the proud daughter of a Navy veteran that served in the Pacific in WW II. She attended Catholic schools, loved dance classes, the cinema on Saturdays.

She graduated St James High School in Haverhill, Class of 1951. After high school, she adventured in Boston, attending Chandler School, to become a secretary in Boston. At her job as a secretary, she met the love of her life, Ted. They eloped over Thanksgiving weekend, on November 26th, 1958, honeymooning in NYC. In 1960, they moved to North Hampton, NH where they lived the remainder of their lives. Barbie was self-described "Domestic engineer," supportive military wife, devoted mother, loyal friend.

Together, Barbie and Ted raised four children, sons Edward E Granger III (wife Kathy), Larry Granger, Steven W Granger (life partner Susan), daughter Susan L. Dunham.

They traveled across the world, visiting Italy, Greece, Morocco, Mexico, throughout the Caribbean, and ancestral homeland of Ireland, as well as many road trips across the USA. She also accompanied Ted to Hawaii on deployment.

In her last years, suffering with dementia, she was lovingly cared for by Steve then Susie, Stephanie and Tim, in her home until her death.

Strong in her Catholic faith, she was a longtime member of Our Lady Parish in Hampton and later St. Teresa Parish in Rye.
