Hampton – Barbara Ann Nerney, 75, of Hampton, NH passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 19, 2020. She was born in Lynn, MA on February 21, 1945, a daughter of the late Charles F. and Virginia M. (Cleary) Baker.

Barbara spent her teen years in Peabody, MA where she graduated from Peabody High with the Class of 1962. She completed a post graduate year at Brewster Academy in Wolfeboro, NH before enrolling at Endicott College. 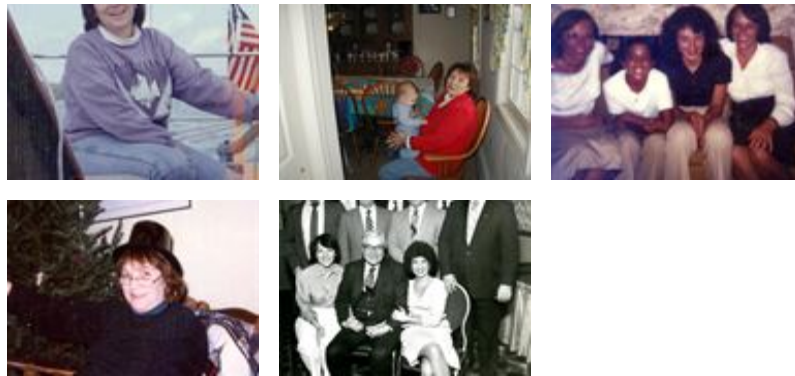
