Barrington – Barry G. Poole, 56, of Barrington, died Wednesday, October 16, 2013 at Maine Medical Center from injuries he sustained in an ATV accident in Barrington last Tuesday.

Barry was born September 21, 1957 in Dover, DE, a son of Lily V. (Dempsey) Beebe of Columbia, SC and the late Donald L. Poole.
