When we moved to the Adirondacks and our family grew, Ben and Stephanie remained in our lives: spending time with us and the children during our annual summer vacations to the Seacoast (catching crabs in the rocks, lighting sparklers, helping me find the sandals I haphazardly placed below high tide line before they floated out to sea, building sandcastles, preparing incredible lobster dinners for us). Their visits to us in Lake Placid (One particular memory that comes to mind was during one of their first visits to our home. I just wanted a hand disconnecting and moving our broken dishwasher; Ben decided on the spot that he could just instantly build a beautiful set of shelves out of scrap wood we had).

The way Ben poured his heart into Stephanie's life was amazing- any interests of hers became his interest for her (such as how much research he put into finding ideal guitars for her)- was amazing to see. The way Ben peacefully battled cancer- the faith he and Stephanie have in God was so clear through everything in his life.

I'm sure this list could go on and on for all of us who knew him. Anyone who met Ben could see right away what an awesome human being he was. May Ben's life serve as an inspiration to the rest of us. Most importantly, Ben has shown us the power of enthusiasm and a kind heart. God bless Ben- I'm sure he has a wonderful spot in Heaven :)

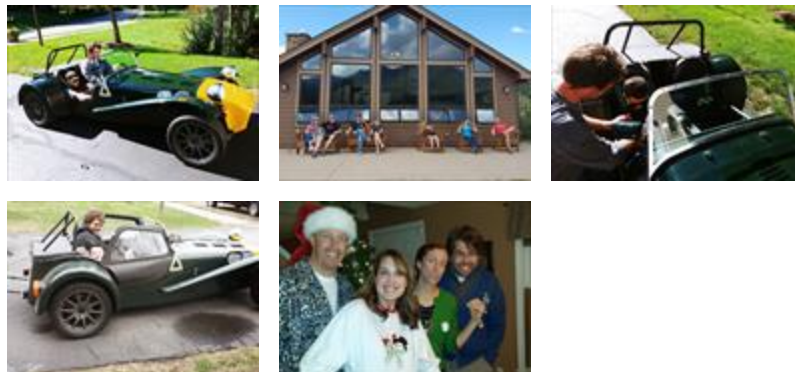
