Rye – Beverly A. Armstrong, 76, of Rye, died Sunday, January 18, 2015 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

She was born in Worcester, Mass., May 14, 1938 the daughter of the late Joseph R. and Dorothy (Reed) Gallant.

Raised in Oakham, Mass., she graduated from Wachusett Regional High School with the Class of 1956. Beverly also lived in Rutland, Mass. for 13 years while raising her family.
