Portsmouth - Beverly Ann Leathers Eddinger passed away June 4, 2025 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital in Portsmouth, NH after a short illness.

Beverly was the second daughter (of 6 children) born to Carroll and Esther (Bartlett) Leathers long time residents of Portsmouth, NH. Beverly attended Whipple Elementary, Portsmouth Junior and Senior High Schools and graduated in 1974.

She was known by all the family and many friends as the 'go to' babysitter throughout her school years before going to work at Portsmouth Hospital where she worked for several years in the housekeeping department. She met Robert Eddinger in 2010 and they married in March of 2012. Many times throughout their marriage Beverly would help out at Ron and Diana's thrift store, getting to know the regular customers, who still ask about her.

Beverly and Robert alternated between Faith Baptist Church of Palm Bay, and Cornerstone of Palm Bay where Bob was a member.

After her divorce in 2016. Beverly returned to New Hampshire to be near other family and her many friends. She ended up back in Portsmouth where she resided until her death.

She leaves her sister Diana Seroski and brother-in-law Ron, her brother Chuck Leathers and sister-in-law Jane, and her sister Nancy Forzese and brother-in-law Joe. Besides her parents, Beverly was predeceased by her brother Allen Leathers of Somersworth, New Hampshire (2017) and David Leathers of Melbourne, Florida (2019), thirteen nieces and nephews, several grand nieces and nephews, and even 5 great nieces and nephews.
