Merrimack – Bruce S. Perkins, 63, of Merrimack, and formerly of North Hampton, passed away on Friday, June 17, 2022 at his home. Along with his late twin brother Brian, Bruce was born in Exeter on December 9, 1958, a son of the late Wilbur and Mary (White) Perkins. He was raised in North Hampton and attended Winnacunnet High School.

At the age of 17, Bruce rebuilt his 1973 Plymouth Barracuda, beginning a lifelong love of cars and motorcycles. A skilled carpenter, Bruce assisted in the construction of many homes over the years, including the complete remodel of his own home in Weare. Following his love of motorcycles, he owned and operated “Choppers Plus” in Goffstown for a time, a shop where he repaired and built many custom motorcycles. Bruce was an avid camper and fisherman and his favorite spot was the First Connecticut Lake in Pittsborough, NH.

In addition to his parents and twin brother Brian, he was predeceased by his youngest brother, Mark A. Perkins.

Bruce is survived by his brother Wayne E. Perkins and his wife Danita of Milford. He also leaves his nephew Andrew Perkins and his wife Tiffany, and great nephew Oliver of Andover, as well as his niece Amy Roberge and her husband Evan, of Deerfield.
