Hampton- Carl James Blomquist, affectionately known as CJ, passed away peacefully on June 9, 2025, after suffering multiple strokes. Born on May 27, 1945, Carl's life was a testament to the values of hard work, resilience, and a deep love for family and community. He lived by the motto "work hard, play hard" and he did both with passion and purpose.

Carl grew up in Haverhill, Massachusetts, and graduated from Haverhill Trade School in 1964, where he honed his skills and ability to fix just about anything. In 1965, he married his high school sweetheart, Kathleen (Osborne) Blomquist. Together, they built a life full of laughter and adventure. Shortly after their marriage, Carl joined the National Guard during the Vietnam War. While he was never deployed overseas, he served honorably within the United States.

At the age of 34, Carl and Kathleen moved their family from the city to Hampton, New Hampshire, where Carl embraced his love of the ocean. Whether swimming, fishing, or digging clams and harvesting oysters, he found peace and strength in the salty air of the seacoast. He also poured himself into building not only homes and additions but also a life of meaning for those he loved.

A natural athlete, Carl enjoyed skiing, hockey, baseball, water skiing, and golf.

He was a proud member of Barefoot Bay Golf Course and brought a relentless can-do spirit to every endeavor, from long hikes to ambitious home projects. His hobbies also included boating, fishing, hunting, dancing, and playing cribbage with family. Known for his kind soul, Carl had a deep affection for animals and was never happier than when a loyal dog was by his side.

Carl was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and friend. He is survived by his beloved wife of nearly 60 years, Kathleen Blomquist; his daughters, Kristina Young (husband Eric Young) and Karen Blomquist (husband Michael Sorensen); and his grandchildren, Cecelia Williamson and Charlotte Williamson. He is also lovingly remembered by his step-grandchildren, Peter Sorensen, Matthew Sorensen, and Erik Sorensen and many beloved nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his parents, Carl and Helen and brothers, Paul and Roger Blomquist.
