“ *I remember all of them -- Carol, Delores, Charlotte, Buster, and their parents. I was Arlen Newman who lived at 440 Hanover Street, diagonally across from the Barrett family. Bachelor John Turner lived to the right of them; the Zubkus family lived to the left of them. My father was the janitor in the nearby Wood Apartments, around the corner at 21 Brewster Street. The Morrissey family lived across the street from the Barretts. I was born in 1932 and was something of a brat. I remember finding a dead rat and holding it up by the tail as I chased Carol and Delores, screaming, up Hanover Street. I may be the only survivor of that neighborhood, and have lived in or near Sacramento, California, since 1959. I graduated from Portsmouth High School in 1950 and from UNH in 1958. My sincere condolences to all of Carol's family.*
