Hampton, NH – Carolyn Ann “Carrie” Hunter, 43, of Hampton, lost her courageous battle with cancer Thursday, March 12, 2015 at Merrimack Valley Hospice House, Haverhill, MA.

Carrie was born April 8th, 1971 in Salem, MA the daughter of Paul O’Keefe of Hampton and the late Francine (Mendalka) O’Keefe.

A longtime resident of Topsfield, MA she graduated from Governor’s Academy in Byfield, MA. She attended Gettysburg College in Gettysburg, PA and then transferred to and went on to graduate from the University of Colorado Boulder in 1993 with a Bachelor’s Degree in Fine Arts. Post-graduation she was employed as a staffing consultant in the Boston, MA area.
