Salisbury - Charles "Charlie" J. Johnson, Jr., 84, a lifelong resident of Salisbury, passed away peacefully on May 10, 2018 at the Beverly Hospital.

He was born on October 8, 1933 in Salisbury a son of the late Charles J. Johnson Sr. and Vera E. (True) Johnson.

Charlie was the proud owner of Johnson's Builders from 1967 until his retirement in 1998. He was an honored member of the Freemasons for 50 years, the Aleppo Shriners of Wilmington, MA and York, ME for 48 years, Eastern Star for 25 years, the local Lions Club and a lifetime member of the NRA. 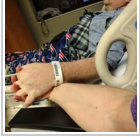
