of 1996. He then opened and operated JLCL Real Estate Development LLC. where he developed and built projects in the Seacoast area.

Chuck was full of intelligence, tenacity, as well as a man of many talents, integrity, and pride.

He is greatly loved, widely respected and missed by all that knew him.

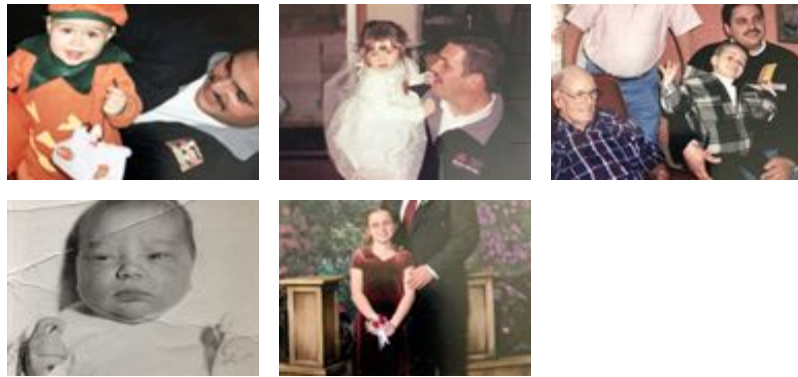

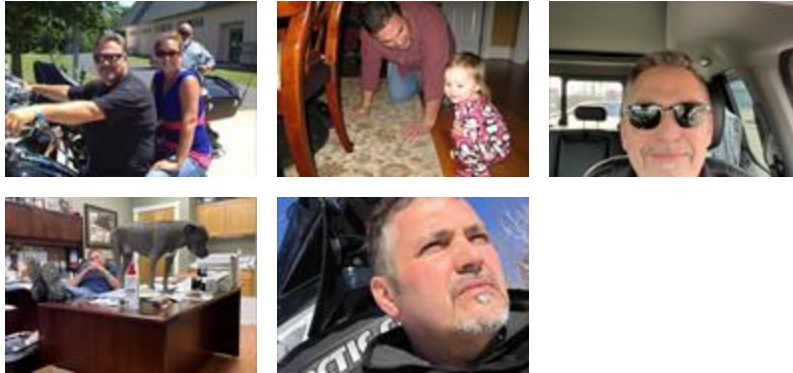

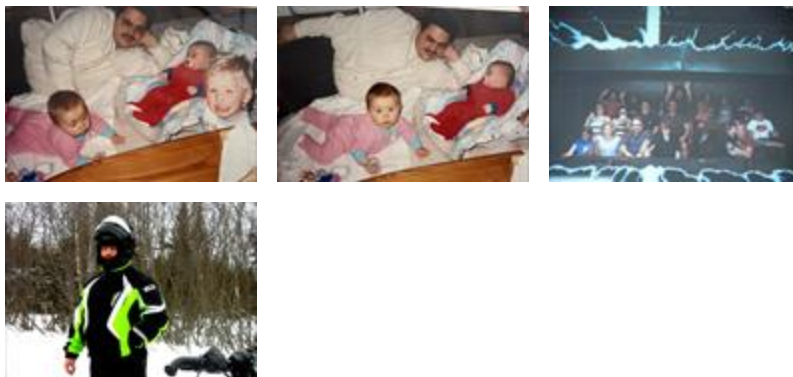
