Osprey, FL – Cheryl L. Burnett, 62, of Osprey, former longtime resident of Hampton, died peacefully on Thursday, April 23, 2020 after a courageous battle with cancer.

She was born on March 4, 1958 in Concord, NH a daughter of Joel S. Reen of Titusville, FL and Karlana (Leavitt) Reen of Contoocook.

Raised in Contoocook, NH she graduated from Hopkinton High School. Soon after she married and moved to Hampton, NH to raise her family. 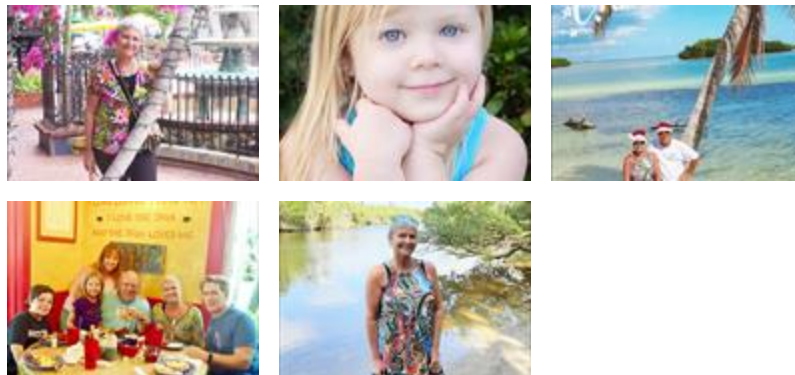
