Hampton – Collette R. Poirier, 73, a former longtime resident of Manchester, died Sunday, October 25, 2020 at Oceanside Skilled Nursing & Rehabilitation Center in Hampton. Collette was born in Manchester on June 26, 1947, and was the daughter of the late Marcel and Angelina (Racicot) LaLiberte. Collette was especially close with her father, and spoke lovingly about him for her entire life.

Collette was raised in Manchester and graduated from the Villa Augustina School in Goffstown, where she made lifelong memories, and often shared stories of her time spent there. As an adult, she was a wonderful and caring mother. She also worked in the lunch program at Jewett Street Elementary School in Manchester for many years.
