Hampton – Cynthia Ruth Jones, 67, of Hampton, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family on Sunday, April 7, 2024 after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer.

Born in Amesbury, MA on September 14, 1956, a daughter of James J. Djerf of Portsmouth and the late Laura (Rose) Djerf. Raised in Hampton, she graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1974.

Cindy was a loving mother raising her two children before meeting her husband, Alan who also had two children. They went on to blend their families where they each gained the privilege of raising children together. She and Alan shared 24 years together, inseparable from the start of their beautiful relationship.

Cindy was kindhearted and always put others needs before her own. She loved the outdoors, especially fly fishing and family camping trips into the Allagash Wilderness Water Way. She also enjoyed traveling with Alan to Northern Maine vacationing at many Maine Sporting Camps. She was well known for being an avid gardener with her husband Alan using all of their harvest throughout the year and canned gifts for those she loved. Cindy and her grandchildren enjoyed painting, arts and crafts and baking together.

Cindy was a longtime active member of the Winnicunnet Rebekah Lodge no. 26 of Hampton where she proudly offered her time and passionate energy in support of those around her. Cindy spent many Wednesday nights during the summer at the North Hampton Bandstand selling baked goods for the Rebekahs fundraising. Cindy was also beloved by the members of Saint James Lodge # 102, in support of her husband and son. She was congregant of the First Congregational Church of Hampton.
